Recycling Guidelines

Recycling is a great way for us to do our part to protect our planet. We have made it even easier for you to help by placing recycling containers next to the regular containers. Items that can be recycled include:

Glass: Clear, green or brown glass bottles and containers. Simply remove lids and rinse them out. Window glass and mirrors are not accepted.

Cans: Aluminum, steel and tin cans. No foil or food trays.

Plastics: Milk, detergent and plastic bottles used for beverages. All plastics can be recycled except film and bags.

Paper: Newspaper, paper bags, magazines, junk mail, catalogs, corrugated containers with no wax coating) and cardboard boxes.
